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Apostolic Foundations

Scripture, Doctrine, Salvation, Discipleship, and Church Order

This certificate course introduces students to the essential foundations of Apostolic faith and practice, including the Bible, Apostolic doctrine and identity, Acts 2:38 salvation, discipleship, holiness, prayer, church membership, Apostolic order, and basic Bible study methods.

Who It Serves: New believers, ministry candidates, church members, Bible teachers, lay leaders, and beginning Bible institute students.

Christian Education

Teaching Scripture with Clarity and Purpose

Who It Serves: Sunday school teachers, Bible instructors, youth teachers, Christian educators, ministry trainers, and church workers.

Church Leadership

Biblical Leadership, Governance, and Ministry Operations

This course equips ministry leaders with biblical leadership principles, church structure and governance, administration, planning, stewardship, communication, conflict resolution, volunteer management, and leadership practicum experiences.

Who It Serves: Department heads, ministry leaders, administrators, pastors, ministers, trustees, deacons, and church workers.

Program Emphasis:

- Servant leadership and church order
- Administration, planning, and communication
- Volunteer coordination and ministry accountability

Ministerial Formation

Calling, Character, Preaching, Ethics, and Ministry Practice

This course develops the spiritual character, biblical understanding, ethical responsibility, preaching preparation, pastoral awareness, evangelistic readiness, and practical ministry skills required for faithful service.

A concentrated twelve-week learning experience that combines guided biblical instruction, Scripture engagement, discussion, applied assignments, reflection, and ministry-focused outcomes within a manageable timeframe.

Who It Serves: Adult learners, pastors, ministers, teachers, church workers, and emerging Christian leaders with active church, work, and family responsibilities.

Apostolic Pastoral Theology (APT-2-TEACH)

Teaching Pastors to Think Theologically and Shepherd Apostolically

This specialized pastoral theology initiative connects Apostolic doctrine with the realities of shepherding, teaching, preaching, decision-making, discipleship, church leadership, and pastoral care.

Who It Serves: Pastors, elders, ministers, ministry leaders, and those preparing for pastoral responsibility.

Guarding the Flock
